RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current NEHC rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. The Committee reserves the right to vary or change show officials or judges. To decline any entry and cancel, divide or combine classes if there are less than four entries.
3. Any horse entered and not exhibited shall forfeit fees, unless the committee is presented with a veterinary certificate or in equitation only, a physician's certificate in the case of the rider. There will be a charge of \$25.00 per entry.
4. The committee reserves the right not to delay classes due to conflicts and not allow substitutions of classes or horses.
5. No exhibitor or person shall approach a judge as to a decision or other matters unless they first obtain permission from the Show Steward. Any exhibitor or person disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees. Judges' decisions are final.
6. Please remember to bring your pony and junior hunter measurement cards and amateur certification. Numbers will not be issued without them.
7. ENTRIES may be faxed to 508-530-3263 until 5:00pm the Friday before the show. After 5:00pm entries will be considered Post Entries. Post entries will be accepted the day of the show, however, there will be a onetime post entry fee of \$25.00. No penalty fee will be charged for entering additional classes on the day of the show.
8. Prize money will be deducted from your horse show bill at the Secretary's office.
9. Schooling will be permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating these rules shall forfeit all entry fees and not be allowed to show.
10. Course will be posted at the gate all day.
11. A trophy and six ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise specified.
12. All horses entered in stake or championship classes must show in one other class in the same division.
13. All dogs must be leashed at all times.
14. The championship and reserve shall be awarded to two of the four horses that have acquired the most points performing over fences in conformation and working classes; only those horses shall receive points for ribbons won in under saddle classes. Champion and reserve in all performance divisions.
Points: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2.
15. All juniors in hunter, jumper, and hunter seat equitation sections cannot ride anywhere on the show grounds without wearing protective headgear passing testing standards. Harnesses must be secured and if said headgear has a brim, it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until his headgear is properly in place.
16. Checks returned for any reason will be subject to a \$50.00 fine.
17. Entries not paid the day of the show will be subject to a \$100.00 fine.
18. Open check written to HMEC must be left with Entry Blank in order to pick up exhibitor number.

Class 58 NEHC Open Pleasure

Entry Fee: \$40

To be shown at a walk, trot or jog, canter or lope. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact. Will be required to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality, in that order. All horses shall be judged on their respective merits regardless of type.

Class 57 Open Schooling Hunter Class (Unrated)

Entry Fee: \$30

No restrictions to age or status of rider. Open all day at the respective height.

Open Equitation Division (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to riders 18 years of age and younger

MHJ Junior Medal

Open to Junior riders. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences not exceeding 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at judge's discretion (USAE tests 1-17). To fill a class at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

Class 54

Entry: \$40

MHC Junior Hunt Seat Medal

Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1 and are members of Mass Horsemen's Council. Course requires 8 fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE tests 1-19). After qualifying, rider is not eligible to enter at future shows. 10 Points are needed to qualify for the finals. 4 competitors must complete the course to fill class.

Class 53

Entry: \$40

SEHA Junior Medal

Open to SEHA Junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current year. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3' 3" in height. One or more tests of the top 4 contestants may be required at the judge's discretion (USEF Test 1-19). To fill a class at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to participate at the SEHA Finals. If you have won the SEHA Junior Medal at the finals, you are no longer eligible for this class.

Class 52

Entry: \$40

NEHC Junior Medal

All riders must present valid membership before entering class. Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Course requires 8 fences not to exceed 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-19) to fill a class; at least 4 competitors must complete the course

Entry: \$40

Adult Equitation Division (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to riders over 18 years of age.

MHJ Adult Medal

Open to all Amateur Adult competitors to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0", spreads not to exceed fence height, with at least two changes of direction and a combination. At the finals, class will be divided 18-30 and 31 and over. At least [2] riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.

Class 48

Entry: \$40

MHC Adult Medal

Open to Amateur Adult members of Mass Horsemen's Council. All competitors are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'6"-2'9" with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at judge's discretion (USAE tests 1-17). To fill a class at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

Class 47

Entry: \$40

SEHA Adult Medal

Open to adult amateur riders. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2' 9" to 3' including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the Finals.

Class 46

Entry: \$40

NEHC Adult Medal

Riders must present a valid membership number before entering the class. Open to adult members of NEHC. Course requires fences not exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF 1-19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course.

Class 45

Entry: \$40

Child/Adult Special Hunter (MHC Rated "C")

Open to Amateur Adult and Junior Riders. No Professionals. Open to Horses and Ponies that have not jumped 3' or over in the previous year, OR Riders who have not shown at 3' or over in the previous year. Fences not to exceed 2'6". No in and outs.

Children's Equitation (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Riders who are eligible for Children's Hunter who have not shown over a course where the fences exceed 3' at a recognized show. Fences 2' for small and medium Ponies, 2'6" for large Ponies and Horses.

MHJ Children's Medal Pony/Horse

Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December first of the current show year and who have not shown over a course where the fences have exceeded 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. A combination is optional and must be adjusted according to fence heights. The same pony/horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per pony (riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class). Fence heights Small/Medium 2' and Large/ Horse 2'6". To fill a class at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course.

Class 38

Entry: \$40

MHJ Mini Medal

Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year [exception Maiden and Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year.]. To perform over at least six fences not to exceed 2'6". At least [2] riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class. Riders may cross-enter into the Children's Equitation Medal but can only compete in either the Mini-Medal or Children's Equitation Medal but not both at the finals

Class 40

Entry: \$40

MHC Mini Medal

Open to riders who have not reached their 15th birthday and who are members of Mass Horsemen's Council. 6-8 fences not to exceed 2'6". One or more individual test of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAETests1-19). After qualifying rider cannot enter this class at future shows. To fill, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

Class 37

Entry: \$40

SEHA Mini-Medal

Open to SEHA members who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1 of the current year and have not competed in any class with jumps higher than 3' with the exception of the USEF Pony Medal. All contestants are to compete over a course not to exceed 8 fences and not less than 6 fences at a height not to exceed 2' 6". No combinations. Contestants are not permitted to cross enter into the National Children's Medal, WIHS, MHC Junior, NEHC Junior Medal and RIHA Junior Medal, USEF Medal, USET or the ASPCA Horsemanship class at any show during the year. To fill a class, at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to participate at the SEHA Finals. If you have won the SEHA Mini-Medal at the Finals, you are no longer eligible for this class. If you have won the SEHA Mini-Medal at the Finals, you are no longer eligible for this class.

Class 36

Entry: \$40

Modified Adult Division (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to adult amateur riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year, has not won 6 blue ribbons at a recognized show in Adult equitation classes. Including Adult medal classes but excluding Modified adult classes. For amateurs who have won 6 blue ribbons, they eligible for Modified Adult, if as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fenced 3' or higher within the past 2 years. Fences not to exceed 2' 6". Riders in this division cannot ride in any other recognized classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6"

MHJ Adult Mini-Medal

Open to all Amateur Adult competitors to perform over at least 8 fences 2'3" to 2'6", spreads not to exceed fence height. Riders may not cross enter regular Adult Medal. At least [2] riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.

Class 33

Entry: \$40

SEHA Adult Mini-Medal

Open to Amateur Adult SEHA members who have not shown over a course where the fences exceed 3' in the current year. To perform over at least 6 fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into the SEHA Adult Medal. At least 2 riders must complete the course. If you have won the SEHA Adult Mini Medal at the Finals, you are no longer eligible for this class.

Class 32

Entry \$40

Pre- Children's/Adult Equitation (Unrated)

Open to riders of any age who have not competed in classes which requires a rider to jump higher than 2'. May be shown by a horse or pony. To be shown at the walk trot and canter in both ways of the ring. May be asked to halt or back.

Opportunity MHJ Short Stirrup Medal

Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 13th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year. To perform over at least four fences not to exceed 18". Riders may not compete in any other equitation class other than Short Stirrup Equitation at any show and shall not have competed in a class jumping over 18". At least [2] riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class. Class 21. Entry: \$40

Opportunity Long Stirrup Equitation (Unrated)

Open to Riders 13 years of age or over. To show over a course of 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". On the flat class will show at a walk, trot and canter. Rider may not show in any class requiring fences higher than 18". Only 8 horses or ponies to canter at once.

17. Long Stirrup Equitation Over Fences Entry: \$25
